Hinchliffe Stadium Exhibition

National Historic Landmark

Hinchliffe, one of the few remaining stadiums that hosted Negro League games, is being completely restored and has been designated a National Historic Landmark.

Over 20 Hall of Famers graced Hinchliffe's hallowed grounds, many of whom played in the Negro Leagues. Completed in 1932, the venue sits on a dramatic escarpment above Paterson's National Historic Landmark Great Falls.

An exhibition will be created in a new facility overlooking the stadium and the beautiful Paterson Great Falls National Park.
